His Holiness (aba), Hazrat Mirza Masroor Ahmad (aba) continued highlighting the life of Hazrat Umar(ra) and the battles and expeditions which he took part in. Huzoor said that Hazrat Umar(ra) took part in all the battles alongside the Holy Prophet(saw). At the time of the Battle of Badr, the Muslims had one camel for every three people. Hazrat Umar(ra) shared a camel with Hazrat Abu Bakr(ra) and Hazrat Abdur Rahman bin Auf (ra).

Khilafat

Hadith (saying of Prophet Muhammad ^{saw}):

"Prophethood shall remain among you as long as Allah shall will. He will bring about its end and follow it with Khilafat on the precepts of prophethood for as long as He shall will and then bring about its end. A tyrannical monarchy will then follow and will remain as long as Allah shall will and then come to an end. There will follow thereafter monarchical despotism to last as long as Allah shall will and come to an end upon His decree. There will then emerge Khilafat on precept of Prophethood." The Holy Prophet said no more. (Masnad Ahmad).

The Promised Messiah ^{as} said:

The Promised Messiah (as) writes regarding his departing this world, and the continued progress of the Jamaat through Khilafat by saying: "...when I depart, God will send that second Manifestation for you which shall always stay with you just as promised by God in Barahin-e-Ahmadiyya...Thus, it is inevitable that you see the day of my departure, so that after that day the day comes which is the day of ever-lasting promise. Our God is He Who keeps His promise and is Faithful and is the Truthful God. He shall show you all that He has promised." (The will, page 7.)

Sacrifice in the cause of God

Hadith (saying of Prophet Muhammad ^{saw}):

“At the occasion of the battle of Tabuk, the Holy Prophet (saw) asked his companions to sacrifice their wealth. Hadrat Umar (ra) narrates that, “Incidentally I had a lot of wealth at that time. So, I thought in my mind that there is no better opportunity to overtake Hadrat Abu Bakr (ra) in financial sacrifice than today. So, I brought half of my wealth to the Holy Prophet Muhammad (saw). When the Holy Prophet Muhammad (saw) asked me what I have left for my family, I replied that I have left half of my wealth. But Hadrat Abu Bakr (ra) brought all of his belongings and when the Holy Prophet Muhammad (saw) asked him what

he has left behind, he answered, I have left Allah and His prophet for my family.’

The Promised Messiah ^{as} said:

“The companions of our Perfect Guide (sa) sacrificed everything for Allah and [His] prophet – they were exiled; persecuted; were troubled with various afflictions and hardships – but they continued to tread on the path of loyalty and steadfastness. So, what was it which made them such devotees? It was the fire of true love of Allah, the flame of which had fallen on their hearts...” (Malafuzat vol.1, p.27)

Men of Excellence: Hazrat Umar (ra) (continuation)

His Holiness(aba) said that Hazrat Umar(ra) was also part of the Treaty of Hudaibiyah. The Holy Prophet(saw) summoned Hazrat Umar(ra) so that he may go to Makkah and inform the Quraish regarding the intentions of the Muslims. Hazrat Umar(ra) said that he feared for his life, because the Quraish knew how much he opposed them. Hazrat Umar(ra) said that if the Holy Prophet(saw) wished, he would still go to Makkah despite this, however the Holy Prophet(saw) remained silent. Then Hazrat Umar(ra) suggested that Hazrat Uthman(ra) be sent, as he was well respected by the Quraish.
